Job Description:

The primary role of CCN Service Coordinator is to ensure that children and youth with special needs access appropriate formal and informal services commensurate with their identified needs and priority for services. The Service Coordinator is responsible for service coordination for families of children and youth and assumes a lead role in facilitating the case resolution process when required. The Service Coordinator will provide professional services consisting of intakes, assessments of needs, referrals, advocacy and consultation.

- Ability to work in both official languages (English & French)
- Ability and experience in coordinating services, empowering clients, and conducting comprehensive needs assessments
- Knowledge of systemic interventions, child development, childhood disorders and syndromes, family/individual mental health assessments and interventions

- Strong interpersonal and conflict resolution skills
- Advanced written and oral communication skills
